Start of School Matters (Term 3)

I hope your child and you have had a restful break these June holidays. With the start of Term 3, we strive to continue working collaboratively with you in providing engaging learning experiences for your child.

1. ATTENDANCE

With the long break, some of our students might need to be familiarized again with the school and class routines to optimize their learning. I would therefore like to emphasize the importance of your child's attendance in school and punctuality every day, which will allow your child to participate actively in lessons, school routines and all activities.

Should your child be unwell and unable to attend school, please provide the Medical Certificate or a letter to explain the child's absence to the Form Teacher on the day the child returns to school next. In addition, I am seeking your support and understanding not to plan for any vacation for your child during the school term as we do not wish to deprive your child of any learning in school. We do not approve of any leave for vacation reasons and strongly encourage our students to attend school regularly.

2. COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS

We warmly welcome all new M1 students and their families joining us this term!

To facilitate effective communication between teachers and parents, we would like to introduce our official communication platform — the **Parents' Portal: "Little Family Room"**. This portal will be used in place of WhatsApp chats for all school-related updates.

Through the portal, our teachers will share:

- Photos and videos of your child's participation in school activities and events

- Updates on your child's learning progress
- Memorable moments captured during the school term

The portal also serves as our main channel for sharing important bulletins and upcoming events. If you haven't already done so, we strongly encourage you to log in and start using the portal to stay connected with your child's Form Teacher.

We seek your understanding that teachers will only respond to messages before lessons begin or after lessons have ended. Responses may be provided on the next working day if messages are sent late in the evening or over the weekend.

If you encounter any issues accessing the portal, please reach out directly to your child's Form Teacher for assistance.

3. SAFETY DURING ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

Please note the following reminders to ensure the safety of all students:

- No vehicular access to the school compound is allowed during reporting and dismissal times, except for school buses.
- Parents who drive should park at the nearby HDB open carpark and drop off / pick up your child at the side gate near Block 18, Eunos Crescent.
- Our staff will be on duty to assist during:
 - Morning drop-off: 7:20 am
 - Afternoon drop-off: 12:35 pm

For late arrivals (after 7:45 am / 1:00 pm):

Please enter via the front gate and report to the security post. Our office staff will contact the Form Teacher as lessons would have commenced. We kindly ask that parents refrain from contacting teachers directly during class hours.

Let us work collaboratively to ensure the safety of our children.

4. STAYING VIGILANT AND SEEKING MEDICAL ADVICE EARLY

7. Early Notice: School Uniform Requirements for M7 Male Students in 2027


We would like to inform parents that [Jeep Sing Fashion](#) will continue to be the school's uniform vendor for the coming year.
